

#### Good morning! —

This morning, I want to continue the sermon series called, "Serving Like Jesus" by sharing Part 2 to a message entitled, "The Jesus Portrait of a Servant". The text is found in Matthew 5, where Jesus begins what has come to be referred to as "The Sermon on the Mount". Jesus begins His sermon with what we call, "The Beatitudes", a series of statements that relate to Christian character and conduct. The Beatitudes are the description of what it means to be a servant, a disciple, and a follower of Jesus! They define the right mind set for the believer and the blessings we will receive when we have them. 


#### **MISSION SPOTLIGHT**

# Serving Like Jesus #4 - The Jesus Portrait of a Servant - Part 2 Matthew 5:3-10

Our text is Matthew 5, where Jesus is beginning His "Sermon on the Mount" with what we call "The Beatitudes". In Jesus' word-portrait of a servant, He emphasizes eight characteristics or qualities. We covered the first four last week and today, we will take a close look at the final four.

- I. A Servant of Jesus is Merciful. Matthew 5:7; James 2:15-16
  - A. Mercy is showing compassion without expecting anything in return. It is "love in action."
  - B. We show mercy by being gentle, kind, and helpful to those in need. Luke 10:25-37; Proverbs 3:27; Psalm 41:1-2 But there is a warning: we receive mercy only when we show it! Proverbs 21:13; James 2:13
- II. A Servant of Jesus is Pure in Heart. Matthew 5:8; Proverbs 4:23
  - A. Pure means, "clean, without defect or blemish, genuine, authentic, not a phony."
  - B. It is in this beatitude that Jesus now turns to the motives behind our works. 1 Timothy 1:5 And we can be looking forward to seeing God. 1 John 3:2-3
- III. A Servant of Jesus is a Peacemaker. Matthew 5:9: Hebrews 12:14
  - A. True peace is not just an absence of conflict. It is an inner calmness, an assurance that God is in control. John 16:33; Romans 5:1; Philippians 4:7
  - B. Servants of Jesus do their best to resolve conflict by pursuing peace. Romans 12:18; 14:19: James 3:17-18
- IV. A Servant of Jesus Endures Persecution. Matthew 5:10
  - A. We should expect our faith to be tested. 1 Peter 1:6-7; 4:14
  - B. Jesus gives us the reason for our persecution in John 15:20a, "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will persecute you as well..."

I hope in these last two sermons we have been able to focus our attention on the portrait of a servant that Jesus has painted. The servant who serves in these ways is truly happy and will be blessed beyond imagination. Blessed are the servants of God, for they will **receive God's promises.**



The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.* 

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior. *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9
- 3) Confessing Christ. Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10
- 4) Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20: John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21
