Overcoming Our Fears Psalm 34:1-7

I came across an article that stated that there are 2000 classified fears. And yet, according to scientists we are only born with 2 innate fears: the fear of falling and the fear of loud noises. In other words, all the other fears are learned fears. We often allow our fears to keep us from accomplishing great things for our Lord and His church. Here are some ways to overcome our fears:

- I. PRAISE THE LORD AT ALL TIMES! Psalm 34:1-3
 - A. **Praise of God's Lordship over all aspects of life** helps us see that He is greater than any fear. Psalm 34:4
 - B. Trust the Lord to take you through whatever dark valley you may be passing through at this time. Psalm 23:4a
 - C. David praised God and then experienced release from his fears.
- II. ADMIT TO AND EXPOSE YOUR FEARS. Isaiah 41:10
 - A. Sometimes our fears are the result of sin. Genesis 3:1-13: Psalm 32:3
 - B. Exposing your fears is simply recognizing what is causing them.
 - C. **Speak out about God's** word, His will and His working in your life instead of being afraid of what others might think of you. Psalm 27:1
- III. LET GOD HELP YOU ELIMINATE YOUR FEARS. 1 John 4:18a
 - A. Fear and love cannot coexist. The closer you get to love the further you get from fear. 1 .John 4:18b
 - B. "Real Christians aren't Christians because they are afraid of the fires of hell. Christians are Christians because they believe in and have fallen in love with Jesus." Tim Spivey see John 8:31-32: 14:6: Matthew 22:37
 - C. Expect the power and blessing of God that comes through prayer. Psalm 4:1

Psalm 34:7 says, "The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and rescues **them."** Sometimes I hear people say that they are afraid about their salvation. They're not sure that if Jesus came today, or if this were the judgment day, whether they would be lost or saved, and they feel insecure about it. There is no need for that! Jesus died so that YOU could be saved!

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior. John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6
- 2) Repenting from sin. Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20: John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21
