The Church That Jesus Built — # 1 — Laying the Foundation

Matthew 16:13-19; Acts 1:1-26

The foundation scripture verse for this series of messages is found in Matthew 16:18 where Jesus said to Peter **"...and upon this rock I will build My church."** — see Matthew 16:13; Philipians 2:8; Matthew 16:14-18

- I. Jesus is the founder of His church. — Matthew 16:18; Acts 2
 - A. God has a plan for the salvation of His creation, and He has a plan for the preservation of His NEW creation, the church.
 - B. **We don't need** creeds or other man-made documents because we cannot improve upon **God's plans.**
- II. Jesus is the foundation of His church. — 1 Corinthians 3:11
 - A. Jesus is the chief corner stone of His church. — Psalm 118:22; Isaiah 28:16 — Compare these O.T. verses with Matthew 21:42; 1 Peter 2:6; Romans 10:11; Acts 4:10-11
 - B. Jesus is the rock upon which we build our lives. — Matthew 16:18; Romans 9:33; 1 Corinthians 10:4
- III. The Church of Christ is built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets. — Ephesians 2:19-22
 - A. The Apostles were not left alone to decide how things were to be done. — Acts 1:1-5
 - B. Jesus was going to give them power in a miraculous way. — Acts 1:8

The old hymn, **"The Church's One Foundation"**, written by Samuel J. Stone says in the first verse:
The Church's one foundation is Jesus Christ her Lord.

She is His new creation, by water and the word.

From heaven He came and sought her, to be His holy bride.

With His own blood He bought her, and for her life He died. PRAISE THE LORD!

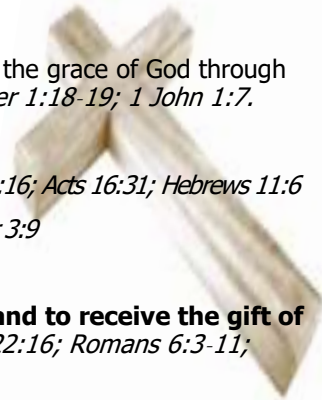

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
