

# The Practices of the Church: The Lord's Supper, Singing, Giving, and Praying

Acts 2:42; 4:31; 16:25; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2

- I. **The Lord's Supper or Communion** - three reasons that we participate in this wonderful privilege every Sunday:
  - A. It is a commandment FROM the Lord. – 1 Corinthians 11:23-25; Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11:20
  - B. It is a proclamation FOR the Lord. – 1 Corinthians 11:26; Ephesians 1:7
  - C. It is a memorial TO the Lord. – Luke 22:19; 1 Corinthians 11:27-29; 10:21, 16-17
- II. **Singing - Three reasons that we "make a joyful noise":**
  - A. God is worthy to be PRAISED! – Acts 16:25; Psalm 30:4; 146:2
  - B. We can be filled with the SPIRIT! – Ephesians 5:18-19; Psalm 95:1
  - C. Singing is a way that we TEACH and admonish one another. – Colossians 3:16
- III. **Giving** - Jesus said, **"Freely you have received, freely GIVE."** (Matthew 10:8) It is all about our attitude. My giving will tell me three things about my faith:
  - A. My **giving will tell me whether I recognize God's complete and unconditional ownership** of ALL I possess. – James 1:17
  - B. My giving tells me where my HEART is. – Matthew 6:21
  - C. My giving is an indicator of how much I TRUST God. – Hebrews 11:6 – Also see Matthew 6:31-33; 2 Corinthians 9:6-7; Acts 20:35; 1 Timothy 6:10; Hebrews 13:5
- IV. **Praying** – The church prays together because:
  - A. We should acknowledge **God's GOODNESS**. – Acts 4:21
  - B. We should **depend on God's POWER**. – Acts 4:23-30
  - C. **We should expect God's ANSWER**. – Acts 4:31-33; Acts 12:5-17 – Also see Ephesians 3:20-21

These practices of the Church that Jesus built are privileges that ALL of us get to participate in when we gather together on Sunday. I pray that we can understand the reasons that we do these things and the blessings we can enjoy as a result.



## WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
