

The Practices of the Church: Evangelism, Fellowship, and Caring

Acts 2:42-47; Matthew 28:18-20; 1 John 1:3-7

- I. Evangelism – is sharing CHRIST with others. – Luke 19:10
 - A. It is a commandment of JESUS. – Matthew 28:18-20; James 4:17; 2 Corinthians 4:13-14
 - B. It is MY responsibility to be a witness. – Ephesians 2:4-5; 2 Timothy 2:15; Proverbs 11:30; Romans 6:23
 - C. The gospel is NEEDED by everybody. – Acts 1:8; 26:28-29; 5:42
- II. Fellowship – is the sharing of our HEART with others. – Acts 2:42-47
 - A. Fellowship builds our FAITH. – 1 John 1:3, 6-7
 - B. Fellowship builds ACCOUNTIBILITY. – Proverbs 27:17
 - C. Fellowship builds UNITY. – Psalm 133:1; Ecclesiastes 4:9, 11-12; Acts 4:32, 34-35
- III. Caring – is sharing the LOVE of Christ with others. – John 13:35
 - A. We care for others because GOD cares for us. – 1 Peter 5:7
 - B. **Caring means we will “bear one another’s BURDENS”.** – Galatians 6:2
 - C. Caring should not just be spoken, but SHOWN. – 1 John 3:18

Galatians 6:10 **teaches us...** “So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.”



WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
