What's In Your Wallet? – Part 2 – Pictures

Hebrews 13:1-8

Why is it that most people like to have quick access to family pictures or other pictures? My guess is **that it's because** those pictures represent people who are precious to us or they capture special memories. A careful look at the main text for this sermon (Hebrews 13:1-8) takes us through the picture section of a person's spiritual wallet. Here are some pictures that may be found there:

- I. Photos of our brothers and sisters in Christ. – Hebrews 13:1
 - A. In spiritually strong relationships the roots go deep. – Romans 12:10; 1 John 3:14
 - B. The presence of brotherly love is a witness to our salvation. – John 13:35
- II. Photos of strangers and prisoners. – Hebrews 13:2-3
 - A. We do a pretty good job of being kind to strangers, but are we offering hospitality to them?
 - B. Though there may not be a lot of Christians in prison, there is definitely a need for prison ministry!
- III. Photos of your spouse and family. – Hebrews 13:4
 - A. It is fun to look at family pictures and reminisce about all the good times. But we must also show our family members how much we care. – 1 John 3:18
 - B. God is asking you to assign the right value to your family.
- IV. Photos of church leaders and those who led you to Christ. – Hebrews 13:7
 - A. How often do you take the time to thank your church leaders and those who shared Christ with you?
 - B. **The #1 recipient of Valentines each year is... teachers!**
- V. A Photo of Jesus! – Hebrews 13:8
 - A. Jesus is mentioned last in this passage not because He is least important but because He is most important. – Matthew 10:37; 19:27-29
 - B. When you make Jesus your #1 relationship, He multiplies your other meaningful relationships. – Phillipians 3:8a

Who is precious to you? Who are you pleased with? Who do you pray for? Who is in your wallet?

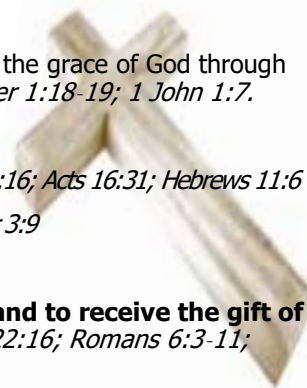

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
