Let Us Not Lose Heart

Galatians 6:9-10; Matthew 11:1-11

All of us tend to lose heart or grow weary from time to time in our day-to-day living. In the social work world it is known as “burnout.” A very dedicated, committed person can become tired of giving, tired of doing, tired of serving and their joy of service is gone. What is true in the secular world is, unfortunately, sometimes true in the spiritual world. The New Testament writers all realized that from time to time, faithful workers for the Lord become weary and need encouragement.

I. Why do those in the Lord’s work “lose heart” (or grow weary) of doing good?

A. We tend to get discouraged, which can lead to doubt. – Matthew 11:1-3

B. There are no observable results.

C. Those who face criticism will sometimes keep them from doing good.

II. What are some ways that we can fight the tendency to **“lose heart”** in doing good?

A. We must focus on the fact that Jesus is alive and working through His people! – Matthew 11:4-6; Titus 3:14; Matthew 5:16

B. We must focus on our eternal reward. – Galatians 6:9, 7-8; Hebrews 12:2; 2 Corinthians 4:16

C. We must focus on our service to the Lord, not on what others may or may not be doing! – 2 Thessalonians 3:10-13; Galatians 6:10

The will of God for each of us is to have a servant’s heart and to keep on doing good!

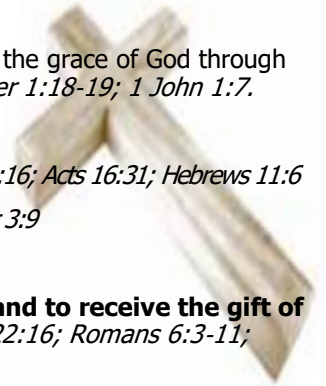

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
