A Back to School Prayer

Proverbs 1:8-10

I want to direct some thoughts to all our young people who are in school, whether you are in middle school, high school, or college. I would like to encourage you by giving you some biblical principles to pray about. But these principles are not just for those in school. These principles to pray about apply to those who are younger, those who are older, and those who are in-between.

- I. SUBMIT TO ALL IN AUTHORITY (that means obey them)! – Proverbs 1:8-9
 - A. It is very difficult to submit to those in authority if you aren't paying attention. – 1 Peter 2:13a; Ephesians 6:1
 - B. Submitting to parental authority brings to us the added beauty of godly character. – Proverbs 1:9
- II. STAND UP TO PEER PRESSURE (that means DON'T GIVE IN)! – Proverbs 1:10; 1 Corinthians 15:33
 - A. Being "accepted" is NOT worth compromising your faith! – 2 Kings 17:15; 1 Peter 2:11-12
 - B. Choose your friends wisely. Decide now what you believe and where you stand or the people you spend your time with will decide it for you.
- III. SERVE JESUS AS THE LORD OF YOUR LIFE (not just your Savior)! – 1 Peter 3:15
 - A. Peter is challenging us all to honor Jesus by setting Him apart as having first place in our lives! – Colossians 1:18
 - B. God's commands and God's plans do not have an age limit. Serve Him NOW! – Philippians 1:6

If Jesus is not your Savior AND your Lord, He can be – TODAY! Believe in Him, trust Him, obey Him, and live for Him!

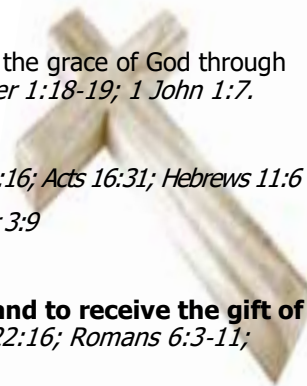

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
