Who is YOUR Boss at Work?

Ephesians 6:5-6

Here is what I want to do this morning. First, I want to answer the question that is asked in the title of this message, "Who is YOUR Boss at Work?" Then, we are going to spend a few minutes talking about how we can use our time at work as an opportunity to serve God; to practice what has been called, "Lifestyle Evangelism".

- I. No matter where we work, our "boss" is **GOD**! – Colossians 3:22-23
 - A. The example of Daniel (Daniel 1-6). Daniel 6:20 – He served God continually!
 - B. God delights in taking ordinary people and infusing them with **extra**-ordinary power.
- II. **EVERY** Christian is a **minister** for Jesus! – Hebrews 6:10
 - A. Your everyday work is a **service** for God. – Romans 12:21
 - B. Here are 4 suggestions for using "lifestyle evangelism" at work.
 - 1. Don't brag! – Proverbs 27:1-2; Luke 18:11-14
 - 2. Don't nag! – A condemning and judgmental spirit will turn people away. – Luke 6:37
 - 3. Don't lag! – If you're lazy on the job, that's a poor testimony for the Lord. – Proverbs 15:19
 - 4. Don't sag! – Be really careful not to go back to your old way of life. – Hebrews 12:1-2a

As a Christian, you carry the saving message of the cross in your heart. So carry it to the workplace **every** day while you are working. Someone desperately needs to hear that message.

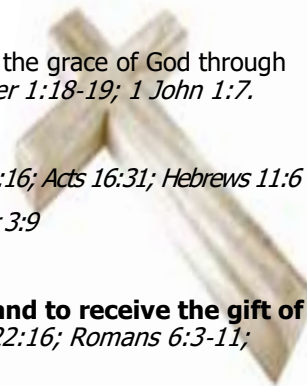

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

The Bible teaches that salvation and the forgiveness of sins is achieved only by the grace of God through the blood of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 26:28; Romans 5:9; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 1 John 1:7.*

The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1) **Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** *John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6*
- 2) **Repenting from sin.** *Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9*
- 3) **Confessing Christ.** *Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10*
- 4) **Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** *Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21*
