The Bible teaches that one receives God's grace by:

- 1. Having faith in Christ, trusting Him as both Lord and Savior.** John 3:16; Acts 16:31; Hebrews 11:6
- 2. Repenting from sin.** Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 17:30; 2 Corinthians 7:10; 2 Peter 3:9
- 3. Confessing Christ.** Matthew 10:32-33; Acts 8:37; Romans 10:9-10
- 4. Being immersed (baptized) into Christ for the forgiveness of sins and to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.** Mark 16:16; Matthew 28:18-20; John 3:3, 5; Acts 2:38, 22:16; Romans 6:3-11; Galatians 3:26-27; Colossians 2:12; 1 Peter 3:21
