- Free admission for Bigs and Littles. Call 423.648.6052 for ticket reservations ahead of time.

Feed Table and Tavern

- Little eats free and unlimited tokens for Little for games.

Hamilton Skate Place

- With every paying skating Big, Little skates free.

Hunter Art Museum

- Admission is free to Bigs and Littles, but you must **call BBBS office at least two days in advance to set up.**

High Point Climbing Gym (downtown location)

- Littles free when their Bigs purchase day pass/equipment (\$26.56). Must bring completed waiver that is signed by parent/guardian to climb. (Waivers can be found on High Point website <https://www.highpointclimbing.com/chattanooga/downtown>).

Highland Commons Soccer (2000 Union Ave. Chattanooga, TN)

- Free event every Wednesday night from 5:30-7 pm. Go to the concessions building and ask for more information. Soccer is played on Field 4. Please wear tennis shoes (Cleats are not allowed!).

Ice on the Landing (*only open Friday before Thanksgiving through Martin Luther King Jr. Day)

- Bigs pay, Littles free.
