COMMENTARY

Indications are that Expenditure will be in line with budget for the full year.

Street Lighting continues to be the main risk of overspend, with aged hardware requiring replacement and higher maintenance costs. A meeting was held with Mr Colt Barratt of Eon with regard to the lack of maintenance on our lamposts. We made a claim for their non completion of maintenance tasks since at least September 2022 and having rejected one offer of recompense from Eon we have subnmitted a slightly reduced claim for which we are currently awaiting a response.

A further financial risk has recently occurred when, following commencement of block paving at the front of the pavillion, two cracks were noticed in two walls, one of which was seen on the interior as well. We are not sure whether this can be covered by insurance (current indications are it will not), but either way, a structural survey is necessary to detrmine remedial action.
