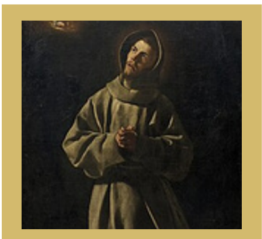
LITURGICAL LIVING AT HOME

Elementary

- What are some things God has given you? Make a quick list! Then, think about how you can **give back**. It's easy to feel like we're doing a lot, but often we're just doing what we're called to do out of love. Talk it over with your parents and choose one 'action item' from your list to work on together this month.
- When you share this month, remember how Jesus always put others first. Try to **give fairly**, or even take the smaller piece so you can give more to a friend, just like He would.

Middle School

- Interview a lawyer or a judge this month and ask them why they believe **justice** is important.
- Discuss with your family how Jesus connected with marginalized people, like the woman at the well or Zacchaeus, and how **St. Katharine Drexel** followed Christ's example. Then, write a "Letter of Encouragement" to someone in a marginalized group or someone who may be overlooked, such as custodial staff, a new neighbor, or a resident of a local nursing home.

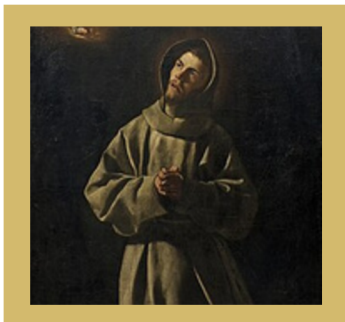

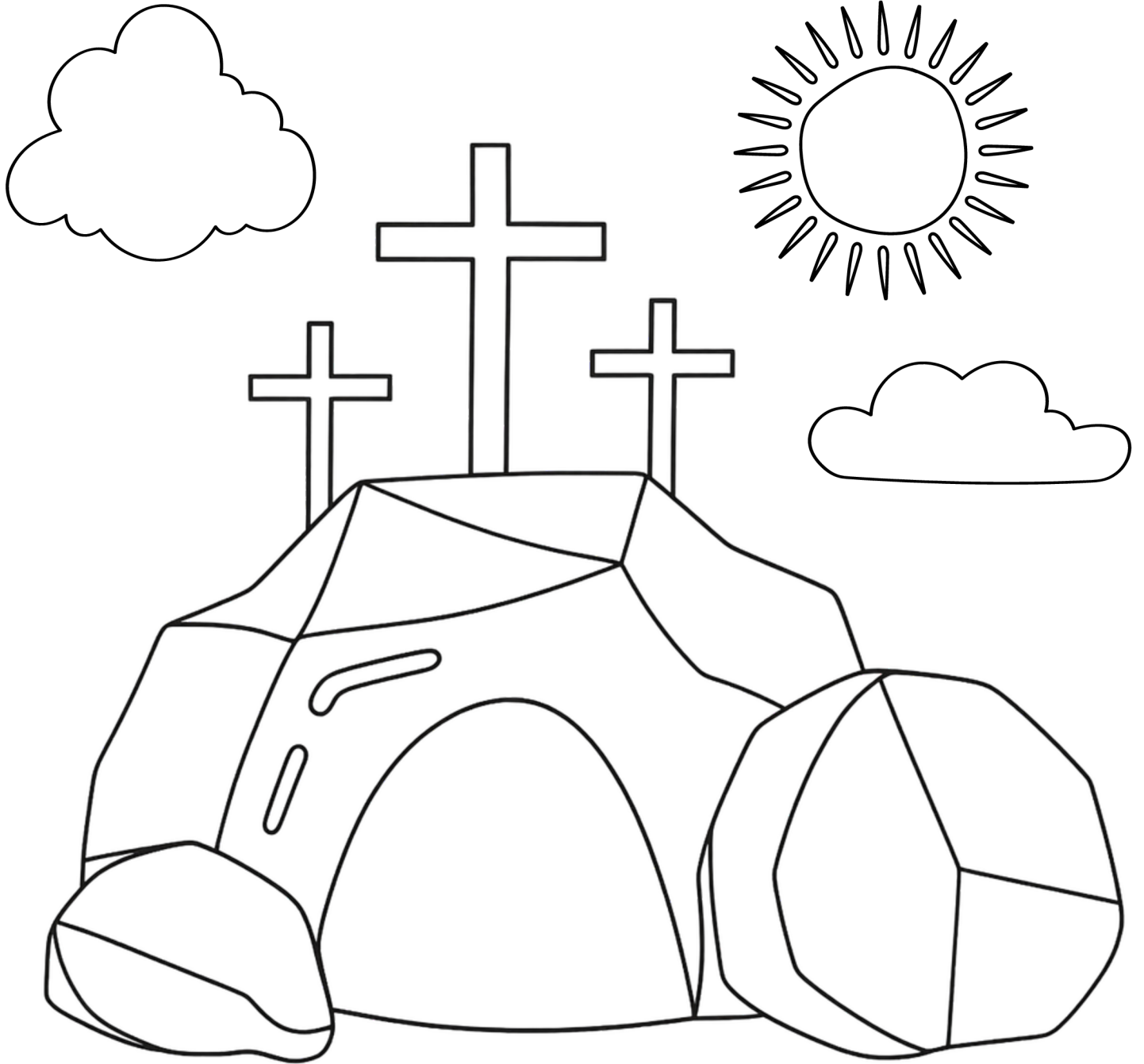
