1. Quick wins you can do yourself

- Make sure your business name, phone number, address, and service area are consistent across your website and Google Business Profile.
- Double-check that your primary services are clearly listed on your homepage.
- Update your homepage headline so it says exactly what you do and where you do it.
- Review your contact page and make sure it is easy to find, easy to use, and accurate.
- Confirm that your website works well on mobile devices and that key buttons are easy to tap.
- Add or update your business hours anywhere customers might see them online.
- Refresh your Google Business Profile description so it clearly explains your services in plain English.
- Upload a few recent, high-quality photos to your Google Business Profile.

3. Strengthen your local SEO foundation

- Write unique title tags and meta descriptions for your key pages.

- Make your content specific to your market instead of publishing generic advice anyone could write.
- Add examples, scenarios, or practical explanations that show real experience.
- Review your content for clarity and usefulness, not just keywords.

5. Improve trust and authority signals

- Add testimonials or review highlights to relevant pages on your site.
- Showcase case studies, before-and-after examples, or project snapshots where appropriate.

- Make your About page stronger by clearly explaining who you are, who you serve, and what makes your team credible.
- Highlight awards, certifications, memberships, or partnerships that reinforce trust.
- Make sure your brand voice sounds experienced, confident, and helpful across the site.
- Check whether your business is mentioned accurately on third-party sites and update anything incorrect.
