Running Bond Brick Wall

100" x 103-1/2"

Quick and Easy!! Good for Beginners!!

Cutting Instructions:

Cut each of the 5 fabrics into 1 yard pieces.

From each of the 1 yard pieces of fabric, cut:

6 strips measuring 5 inches x **Width of Fabric**.

You should end up with a total of 60 strips. See illustration below.

Next, from each of the strips, cut 3 rectangles measuring:

5 x 8, 5 x 12 and 5 x 20 inches

You should have 60 rectangles of each size. There will be extras.

8"	12"	20"	
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Sewing Instructions:

1. Following the layout diagram, randomly arrange the rectangles into four horizontal rows, creating 1 unit.
2. Make sure you have an arrangement that pleases you, **before sewing**. Rearrange if necessary. *There is not a right or wrong way!!*
3. Sew rectangles together using 1/4 inch seams. Press.
4. Join the first 4 rows, forming a unit.
5. Repeat the first 3 steps to make a total of 6 units (Leave last row off if you want to use 108" Backing)
6. Join all units together to make quilt top. Press.
7. Add batting and backing. Baste, quilt and bind.
8. Binding can be made from the left over rectangles.
9. Tip:
Number each of your 16 rows after you have laid them out. You can pin a numbered scrap paper to the first rectangle of each row. Pick up each of the rows in the same order, from left to right.
