1 Carissa Parker (Bloom Studio) 🍷
Carissa creates hand-built ceramics, illustrations, and experimental mixed-media works. Inspired by nature, imperfect forms, and creative play.

1 Denise Gillies & Lynne Mitchell 🍷💎
Ferguson Valley artists Lynne and Denise are printmakers and mixed media artists whose shared environmental philosophy led to their collaborative partnership, LinkD, creating framed artworks, jewellery, textiles and cards.
