Registration Information

Summer school registration is open for students currently in Grades 9 to 12. All courses will be in-person at St. Jean de Brébeuf Secondary School and Cathedral High School.

How to Register

1. Complete the *Permission to Attend* form with the course code of the course you would like to take.
2. For students of the HWCDSB, please log into myBlueprint on mysite and choose your summer course. (Steps 1 & 2 must be completed before the student meets with the guidance counsellor)
3. Submit the *Permission to Attend* form to your home school guidance counsellor.
4. Your home school will verify and submit your form to St. Charles.

Registration runs from April 1 until June 1, 2026.

Late registration will open June 24, 25 (4-7pm) and June 29, 30 (8am-2pm)

Please register early as space and availability may be limited. Courses are subject to sufficient enrolment and staff availability. Should courses not run, students will be contacted and will have the option to learn through Online Summer School.
