Registration Information

Summer school registration is open for students currently in Grades 9 to 12. All courses are online and asynchronous.

How to Register

1. Complete the *Permission to Attend* form with the course code of the course you would like to take.
2. For students of the HWCDSB, please log into myBlueprint on mysite and choose your summer course. (Steps 1 & 2 must be completed before the student meets with the guidance counsellor)
3. Submit the *Permission to Attend* form to your home school guidance counsellor.
4. Your home school will verify and approve your myBlueprint selection and submit your completed form to St. Charles.
