OPEN CALL: STAC Residencies

STAC are delighted to announce a series of five, one-week residencies (Monday to Friday) for artists of all disciplines* from June to September 2026 (see [STAC Residencies Form](#) for available weeks. This link will re-direct you to the online application form).

The aim of these one-week residencies is to facilitate collaboration between artists who wish to work together, but who have otherwise not had the time and/or space to do so. Each residency will receive a stipend of €1200, based on two individuals, regardless of the number of artists per application, so please consider this carefully if applying with more than two artists. Artists must deliver a public engagement element as part of this residency opportunity.

Please read the following criteria carefully

- Minimum of TWO artists per application. At least ONE artist per application MUST be domiciled in either counties Tipperary, Waterford or Kilkenny.
- Applicants MUST be available to be in STAC Chapel for the duration of their residency.
- Applicants MUST deliver a public engagement element on the last day/Friday of their residency.
- This opportunity is not suitable for artists working in an individual capacity.

* This residency is suitable for visual artists, multi-disciplinary artists, writers, poets, musicians, composers, theatre practitioners, dancers and film-makers, HOWEVER, STAC Chapel is a protected building and as such the use of certain materials is not permitted. This residency is NOT SUITABLE for studio based artists who work with water/solvent-based media, paint, plaster, cement, or any other materials of this nature. (If in doubt about the appropriateness of your practice/materials, please contact info@southtippartscentre.ie before proceeding with your application.)

Application requirements

Only one application per artist duo is required. Applications should contain the following:

- A proposal (max. 700 words) outlining your intended use of the space during your residency — tell us about how this collaborative residency will benefit/develop the practice of both participating artists.
- Up to 5 images/media links per artist (10max.)
- Artist's CV/bio for each applicant.
- Specify your availability via [STAC Residencies Form](#).
