Getting Here

By Car

- Route 1 From Dublin (M9)
Follow the M50 Southbound and join the M9 route heading towards Carlow and Kilkenny. Take Exit 9 and follow signs to Clonmel.
- Route 2 From Cork & Dublin (M7/M8)
Follow the M50 Southbound and join the M7/M8 route heading towards Portlaoise and Thurles. Take EXIT 8 and follow signs to Clonmel.
- Route 3 From Limerick & Waterford
Follow the Clonmel signs along the N24

Parking

Parking is available in the car park (paid) alongside Kickham Barracks (accessible via Davis Road) and in the Free Car Park on the Old Waterford Road (5 minute walk from venue). There is also street parking available as well as parking at Showgrounds Shopping Centre. (See Map)

By Train

Irish Rail offers a daily route from Waterford to Limerick Junction that serves Clonmel. Change at Limerick Junction for services to Limerick, Cork and Dublin. Visit irishrail.ie for further details

By Bus

Bus Eireann offers a number of routes servicing Clonmel, including Route 55 (Waterford to Limerick) and Route 245 (Cork to Clonmel). Visit buseireann.ie for journey planner and more information on connecting routes.

JJ Kavanagh are an independent bus provider that provides a Clonmel to Dublin service with pick up and drop off outside Kickham Barracks.

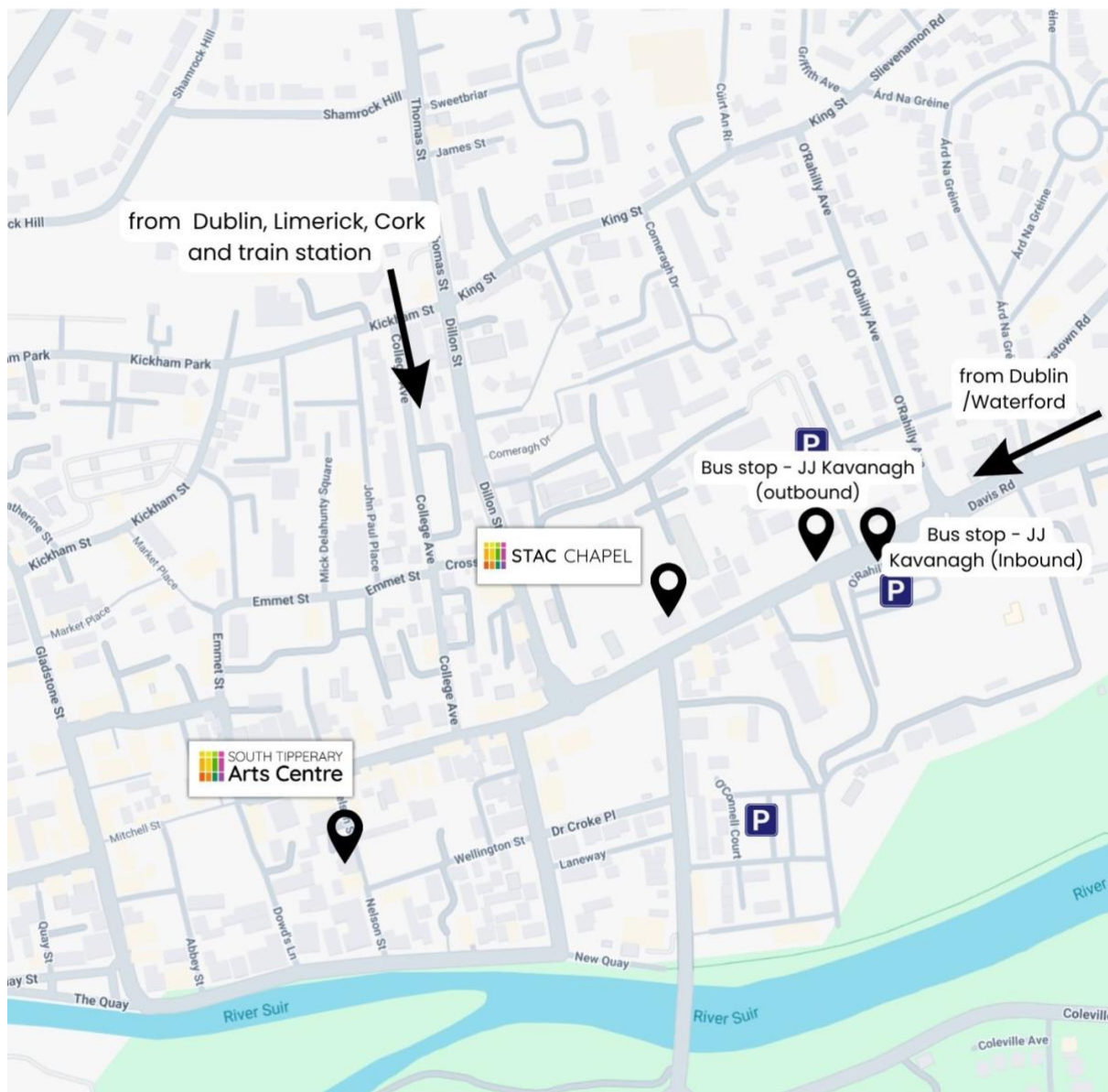

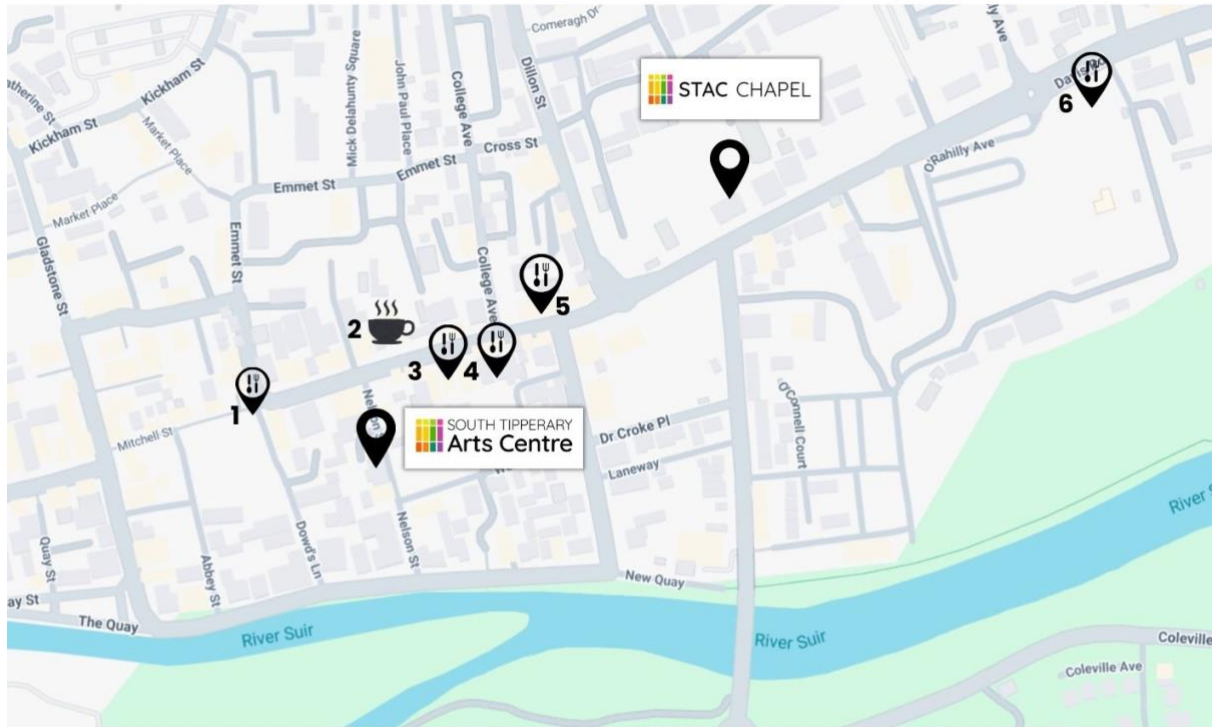
