



2025 LPEF College Emergency Grants Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What is the 2025 College Emergency Grant?

The 2025 College Emergency Grant is a financial assistance program offered by the Lynwood Partners Educational Foundation (LPEF) designed to assist LUSD alumni with their college-related expenses and unexpected financial difficulties that have presented a financial emergency.

How much financial assistance can I receive through this grant?

Eligible applicants can receive grants of up to \$500 to help cover emergency expenses.

What expenses are considered eligible for this grant?

The grant can be used to cover several of the following eligible expenses:

- Tuition
- Books and materials
- Computer or tablet
- Campus parking pass
- Personal automobile expenses and gasoline
- Public transportation or bus pass

Who is eligible to apply for the 2025 College Emergency Grant?

To be eligible for this grant, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a 2023, 2024, or 2025 graduate from the Lynwood Unified School District.
- Be enrolled in a valid college, university, or trade school.
- Upload a current, unofficial college transcript for the 2025-2026 academic year.
- Be facing an unforeseen emergency financial need or expense that presents a challenge in your educational journey.

What qualifies as an "emergency financial need" for this grant?

An emergency financial need is a sudden and unexpected expense that, if not addressed, could significantly hinder your ability to pursue your education. This might include unexpected FAFSA changes, medical bills, car repairs, or other unforeseen costs.

How can I apply for the 2025 College Emergency Grant?

To apply for this grant, you will need to complete the application provided by LPEF. Be sure to follow the instructions and provide all necessary documentation. You can find the application at: <https://smr.to/p105264>

When is the application deadline for this grant?

The application deadline is Friday, November 7, 2025.

How are applicants selected for the grant?

Selection for the grant is based on a scoring rubric that takes into account a combination of factors, including the nature of the emergency, the financial need, and the available funding.



Is this grant renewable for multiple semesters or school years?

The 2025 College Emergency Grant is typically a one-time grant. However, if you continue to face financial emergencies in subsequent semesters, you may reapply, but there is no guarantee of receiving additional funding.

Is this grant available for multiple years?

Please be aware that the grant's annual availability is contingent upon funding and is not guaranteed.
