Reflection

“God’s love is being poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us”.

We are about to reach the mid-point of Lent and there will soon be an expectation of the joy and the wonder that will be revealed in the events of Holy Week. It is important that we allow this time to sink deep within us. Today’s gospel of the Samaritan woman meeting Jesus at the well is an extraordinary teaching upon how Our Lord wants to give us the Holy Spirit which is what allows us to love and to be joined to the Godhead. Try imagining that you are the Samaritan woman going to the well and of how Jesus wants to open you up to receive and to know His love. Let Him speak to you of your frailty and sinfulness so that He can give you this restoring love through the Holy Spirit. There are various things which I would like to bring to your attention and also ask for your prayer. **First**, I am going on retreat from this Sunday for eight days which of course is a very precious time and I would ask you to pray for me as I will of course pray for you. During those eight days, we have other priests who will come in and celebrate Mass and if you could please support them, that would be great.

Second, this weekend we have an appeal for Open House and Breakfast Club – hoping to raise money to pay for this beautiful service in the life of the parish. There will be reflection from the pulpit this Sunday and next Sunday will be the opportunity to contribute, either by way of a retiring collection or through our contactless machines.

Third, we celebrate our patronal Feast on Monday 16th and Tuesday 17th March. Please look for the notices and come to Mass and invite friends, family and neighbours to come along. It is also a time for relaxation of our Lenten discipline!

Fourth, there is the return of the Oratory choir for the Stations of the Cross on Wednesday 18th March. It is a beautiful evening in which we pray for the work of Aid to the Church in Need and their support of persecuted Christians.

Above all, we pray that the love that is being poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit will enable us to be strong ambassadors for bringing God’s love into our world, communities, families and friends.

May God bless you in these days as we prepare for the great events of Holy Week.
