And stood in the midst of his disciples and said: Peace be with you. The disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. Alleluia.*

**Ave Verum Corpus (F. Liszt 1811-66)**

**Translation:** *Hail the true body, born of the Virgin Mary: You who truly suffered and were sacrificed on the cross for the sake of man. From whose pierced flank flowed water and blood: be a foretaste for us in the trial of death. O sweet Jesus, O gentle Jesus, O Jesus, Son of Mary. Have mercy upon us. Amen.*
