



STANDING WITH OUR NEIGHBORS | CALL TO ACTION

We must go to the seats of power and say NO to the systems of domination and YES to God's way.

Start with ONE thing!

YOU CAN contact your congressional representatives and tell them to protect fair access to voting – the keystone of democracy – and say NO to the SAVE Act.

In Polk County, **YOU CAN** contact Sheriff Schneider and tell him to stop cooperating with ICE.

In any community, **YOU CAN** attend your city council and county boards meetings and urge them to focus on the issues that are affecting the wellbeing of the people in our community.

- Ask them to care for all people, including the immigrant and refugee communities and others from marginalized groups, through supportive policies and actions.
- Direct law enforcement to NOT cooperate with ICE and tell ICE to leave our communities.

YOU CAN support the work of Iowa Migrant Movement for Justice (IMMJ) and other organizations working with the immigrant and refugee communities.

- Invite IMMJ to speak with your congregation and groups about the breadth of services and work they offer to support our neighbors born in other countries.
- Sign up for the IMMJ emails to learn about their work, including their accompaniment program, and how you can literally stand with your neighbors.
