



Nieuport Aviation Pet Policy

Pets are welcome when traveling through the terminal, or when accessing the airport on the Billy Bishop Airport shuttle bus. Pets must always remain in their carriers, unless they are service dogs, going through airport security, or using one of the terminal pet relief areas. These guidelines are in place for the health, safety and comfort of everyone.

Passengers are encouraged to check with their airline for specific information on traveling with pets and any restrictions.

Terminal Pet Relief Area Locations

Pet relief areas are available at two locations post security:

- Domestic Lounge area
- Transborder area, prior to entering the lounge

There is an outdoor pet relief area located on the Island south of the Main Terminal Entrance.

Service Animals

Service animals are welcome at Billy Bishop Toronto City Airport and on the airport's shuttle bus. Service animals must be leashed at all times except in limited circumstances. For more on related guidelines from the Government of Ontario on service dogs, please click [here](#).
