Job Summary

OCL Custom Crushing and Quarrying Ltd. is currently seeking a Crusher Supervisor for the Lorne Falls Quarry near Sudbury, Ontario.

The Crusher Supervisor is responsible for skilled work that involves supervising, coordinating and scheduling the activities of workers, overseeing the safety of the quarrying operations, and assist in recommending measures to improve daily productivity.

As the Crusher Supervisor, it is necessary to have competency operating crushers and using screeners, along with having a strong supervisory background. An in-depth understanding of the conveyors, loaders and other associated aggregate and mobile heavy equipment is also necessary.

The Crusher Supervisor will also work alongside OCL Custom Crushing and Quarrying Ltd.'s sister company Z'gamok Construction LP.

- Safely operate the crusher to complete a variety of aggregate materials as per specifications; safely operate other heavy-duty equipment as required for the project
- Check stockpiles to ensure product quality and mix material to desired consistency
- Perform daily checks on conveyors, screen deck and crusher box
- Maintain equipment in good operating condition, reporting and logging maintenance requirements or concerns
- Address any crusher issues and requisition wear parts immediately
- Complete daily paperwork accurately including timesheets, pre-operational inspections, pre-tasks assessments; ect.
- Resolve work problems and recommend measures to improve daily productivity
- Oversee the safety of all quarrying operations and conduct safety meetings
- Train employees in job duties, safety procedures and company policies
- Comply with all company policies and procedures
- Work in accordance with all local health and safety laws and regulations
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) at all times
- Other duties as assigned
