

Pipers Brook 2023

Pinot Noir

AROMA

Abundant black forest fruits of red and dark berries, with red cherry and hints of strawberry, complex and earthy with alluring spice notes.

PALATE

Layers of mixed berries and dark cherry fruits with savoury elements and depth of earthy spice. Wonderfully textured mid palate with fine velvety tannins and lasting intrigue.

WINEMAKING

Whole bunches were carefully de-stemmed, with berries remaining intact. Fermentation via a combination of wild and inoculated yeast took place in small open vats, with 15% whole bunch included in the ferment.

A combination of hand plunging and pumping over was employed throughout ferment. The resulting wine was gently pressed in a basket press and aged on lees in French oak barrels in our cool underground cellars for 9 months.

Bottled under screw cap to preserve intensely perfumed aromatics and expressive fruit.
