

Pipers Tasmania 2024 Rosé

A modern expression of a Tasmanian icon. Pipers Tasmania Rosé expresses vibrant raspberries, wild strawberries and fresh cream, pomegranate and a touch of spice, with a silky texture and delicate natural acidity in this dry style rosé'.

AROMA

Raspberries, wild strawberry and fresh cream, hints of cherry and red apple

PALATE

Fresh red berries and pomegranate with a touch of spice, silky texture with delicate natural acidity in this dry style rosé

WINEMAKING

Selectively picked in the cold morning hours, the naturally chilled fruit was soaked on skins for 6 hours before gentle pressing. This juice was then cold settled and transferred to a combination of barrel and stainless-steel tanks for fermentation. Wild fermentation was allowed to commence prior to inoculation with *Saccharomyces* yeast. Following primary fermentation, the wine was aged on lees to give fullness and texture prior to blending and bottling.
