The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “Committee”) for the bankruptcy estate of Power Block Coin, LLC (the “Debtor”) in the above-captioned bankruptcy case, by and through its counsel of record, hereby files this *ex parte* motion (the “Motion”) seeking an order authorizing the subpoena of and production of documents by Fireblocks Inc. a/k/a Fireblocks Ltd (“Fireblocks”) under Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2004 and Local Rule 2004-1. 3. Based on information obtained by the Committee, Fireblocks may have information regarding the Debtor's acts, conduct, property, liabilities, and financial condition that are relevant to this bankruptcy proceeding and the administration of the Debtor's estate.

4. Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2004 and Rule 2004-1 of the Local Rules, the Committee requests an Order authorizing the Committee to issue a subpoena to Fireblocks to produce documents to Abigail Stone, GREENBERG TRAURIG, LLP, 222 South Main Street, Suite 1730, Salt Lake City, UT 84101, including documents concerning the Debtor's cryptocurrency transactions and any other relevant information Fireblocks possesses concerning the Debtor's acts, conduct, property, liabilities, and financial condition.

5. The undersigned counsel hereby represents that the deadlines to produce documents will provide Fireblocks with not less than 14 days of written notice.

WHEREFORE, the Committee requests that the Court enter an Order authorizing the Committee to issue all necessary subpoenas. The Committee will serve Fireblocks with the Court's Order, together with subpoenas incorporating the documents and information outlined above.
