PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Acting United States Trustee has filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah a Motion (“Motion”) for an order to disgorge interim fees and expenses paid (approximately \$191,873.46) and to prohibit future payments of attorney fees from the estate due to Debtor’s Counsel’s failure to disclose the source of payment of attorney fees and failure to disclose potential connections and conflicts for failing to disclose

the source of payment of attorney fees awarded by this Court in the Order Authorizing Payment of Allowed Fees and Expenses of First Interim Application of Parsons Behle & Latimer entered at Dkt. #238 as required by 11 U.S.C. § 329(a) and Bankruptcy Rules 2014 and 2016; and for failing to disclose a Joint Defense Agreement as required by Bankruptcy Rule 2014.

Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. (If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.)

(1) The Motion has been scheduled for hearing on **February 17, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**, before the Honorable Cathleen D Parker, United States Bankruptcy Court Chief Judge. The hearing will be held by Zoom. If you or your attorney do not take the steps listed above, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought in the Motion and may enter an order granting that relief without a hearing.
