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**SECOND ORDER CONTINUING HEARING ON MOTION FOR RELIEF
FILED BY BLUE CASTLE HOLDINGS, INC.**

Blue Castle Holdings, Inc. filed its *Motion to Terminate the Automatic Stay With Respect to the Management Services Agreement* (Dkt. No. 428, the “Motion for Relief”), which was initially scheduled for hearing on December 16, 2025 and subsequently rescheduled for January 20, 2026. The Court presently has under advisement the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors’ *Motion to Appoint Chapter 11 Trustee* (Dkt. No. 413) and the Debtor’s *Ex Parte Motion to Convert Case to Chapter 7* (Dkt. No. 422). The Court believes that the goals of judicial efficiency and preservation of parties’ resources would be better served if it issued its ruling on the motions under advisement before addressing the merits of the Motion for Relief.

Therefore, and pursuant to the Court’s “inherent authority to manage [its own] docket,”¹
the Court hereby **ORDERS:**

1. The hearing on the Motion for Relief is continued to **March 31, 2026 at 10:00 a.m.**
2. The automatic stay shall remain in effect pending the continued hearing.
