ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2025 LAWN TENNIS ASSOCIATION OF MALAYSIA (TENNISMALAYSIA)

Kuala Lumpur, 28 December 2025:

The Lawn Tennis Association Malaysia (TennisMalaysia) the national governing body of tennis in Malaysia, successfully convened the 2025 Annual General Meeting (AGM) on Sunday, 28th December 2025. The meeting was attended by 53 out of 57 eligible delegates reflecting strong representation from its affiliates. The AGM was observed by Mr R Suresh Kumar from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, while Mr Ruhil Amal Razali served as the independent Scrutineer to ensure transparency throughout the election process.

During the meeting, delegates unanimously endorsed the TennisMalaysia's annual reports which included reports on the Audited Financial Report, Tournament and Officiating Reports, Development Programmes, National and the Junior National Squads' activities, as well as the Social Media and Promotion initiatives undertaken during the year.

The main agenda of the AGM 2025 was the election of the new TennisMalaysia Committee members for the forthcoming term. The positions contested comprised one (1) President, three (3) Vice Presidents and seven (7) Executive Committee members, alongside the appointment of the Honorary Secretary and Assistant Honorary Treasurer

Mr Mirzan Mahathir, the incumbent President was re-elected unopposed. The elections of the Vice President and EXCO positions were keenly contested with four (4) nominees contesting the the Vice Presidency and thirteen (13) nominees vying for the EXCO seats.

The AGM also deliberated on a motion proposing that Tennis Wheelchair Malaysia be placed under the governance of TennisMalaysia. In support of this transition, Malaysia Paralympic Council will assist TennisMalaysia in managing and overseeing Wheel Chair Tennis operations until full operational readiness is achieved.

Subsequent to it Mr Mirzan Mahathir announced the appointment of Ms Maria Fauzana Ghazali, currently the Honorary Secretary of Kuala Lumpur Lawn Tennis Association (KLLTA), as the new Honorary Secretary of TennisMalaysia.
