Council of Nicea – History






The First Council of Nicaea was convened by the Roman Emperor Constantine I in 325 in the small town of Nicaea (now Iznik, Turkey) near Constantinople (now Istanbul) to settle the dispute over Arianism. We shall look at the Council in three separate sessions, every second Sunday of the month, looking at its History (14th September), Outcome (12th October) and Reception (9th November) to appreciate more deeply the Creed we profess at every Sunday Mass with the whole Church.


