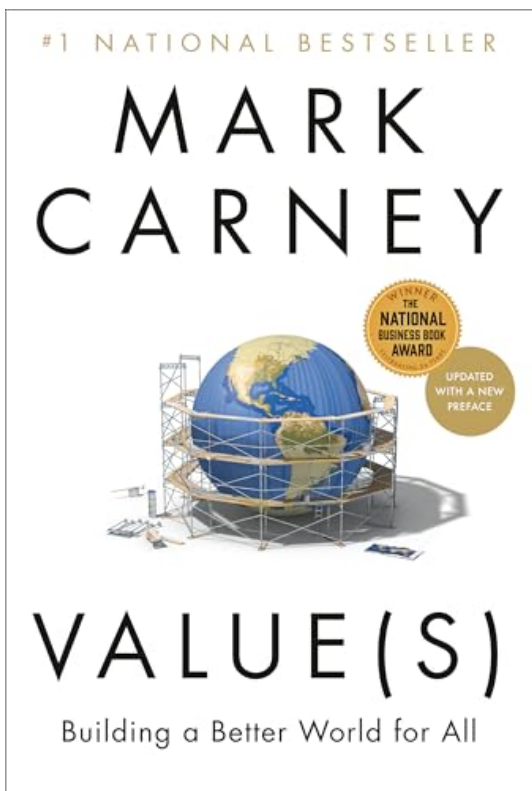
FOCUS ON VIRTUES

The significance of Awaiting Pentecost LITURGY

We will look at how the Easter season leads up toward a solemn Catholic liturgical celebration held on the Saturday evening before Pentecost Sunday, marking the end of the Easter season. Similar to the Easter Vigil, it often features an extended form with multiple Old Testament readings focusing on the Holy Spirit's role, culminating in the anticipation of the Spirit's descent.

Fr Gerard Mitchell SJ is Parish priest of St Aloysius, Garnethill in Glasgow. Before this, he served the Southall community in London as parish priest of St Anselm's Catholic Church from 2009 until 2021. While serving at Sacred Heart Church in Wimbledon, he was one of the founders of Faith in Action, Merton Homelessness Project. He continued his work with street homelessness in Southall. He was joint chair of Faith Forum for London and a member of the board of Responsibility for Heathrow Airport Multi-Faith Chaplaincy.
