Previous Meeting Minutes Acceptance: Tony made a motion to accept February minutes – Michele seconded – all present were favor.

Report of Treasurer:

- 2026 Income YTD - **\$169,057.50**
- 2026 Expense YTD - **\$14,652.31**

Old Business:

- 2025 Invoicing Progress – **Only 3 – 2025 invoices have not been paid. Ohio Laser – around \$600, 1848 Dawgs – around \$2000+ and Tessie Covret - \$55**
- MJBSA Calendar Access – **Tony to discuss their temporary procedure to edit their block out dates**
- Shelter House Project Update – **Location has been identified and flagged. Jennifer to review with Segner construction. Start of project TBD.**
- Eagle Scout Project – Evan Holshu - **Evan provided a Lowes quote for the material. Dave to meet Evan and his mother, Janet, at Lowes to purchase. Michele Daniel to acquire quote for AED systems. Tony to see if MFD would service.**

New Business:

- **UCISL (Melaney email) – Reviewed her email – no action taken.**
- **Storm Damage**
 - **Lee Property – Greg Lee expressed their concern of UCJRD driving onto their fields to pick up trash and anything that may have blown into the fields. Short term solution will require UCJRD to contact Lee's if need to retrieve anything – Long term would be to install fencing.**
 - **Roof? – Dave indicated that there has been storm damage to the siding and roofs of buildings. County will be filling a claim with CORSA. Dave to meet with Monarch Roofing to acquire quotes for submission.**
- **Property Opportunity – Chad presented a handout in regard to approximately 97 acres of land within the county to be developed for recreation. Current owner would be willing to sell with stipulation it remains a park of some sort. The city**

and county will work on options and possible grants to acquire for UCJRD. 2 to 3 years out. Larry made a motion to acquire under UCJRD – Aaron seconded – all present were in favor

- **2026 Online User Agreement**
 - **2027 Online User Agreement**
 - **Increase Fees? – Tony made a proposal to increase user fees in 2027 – Dave seconded – all present were in favor.**

- **Ballfield Lights LED Conversion Issues – Dave indicated that there was an issue with installing the LED lights on existing poles. Delaware Electric indicated that they would work with the manufacturer on a solution. Electrical contractor will convert back to existing lights – Delaware Electric said they would pay for the contractor service to do so. Mike confirms existing lights are working.**
 - \$55,705.53 Material
 - \$28,500 Labor
 - \$84,205.53 Total
