Please note: Any tables used for cakes, gifts, or decorations must also function as dining tables for guests.

OUTSIDE DESSERTS

You're welcome to bring a birthday cake or dessert for your celebration.

We highly recommend desserts from Honeymoon Bakery, part of our Collective Hospitality restaurant group.

Per Health Department guidelines, outside desserts must come from a licensed bakery or grocery store. If you'd like to bring a homemade dessert, no problem. We'll simply ask you to sign a quick waiver upon arrival.

OUTSIDE FOODS

Outside appetizers, snacks, trays, or catered food are not permitted. We have plenty of shareable options on our menu and would love to help feed your group.
