Who is the ECA program for?

The Early Childhood Approach (ECA) program is designed to support children under nine years of age that have a disability, or under six years of age that may have a developmental delay or concern.

The ECA Program recognises that a child's early years are important for their long-term development and help lay the foundation for their future abilities.

A diagnosis is not required to access the program as the focus is on early childhood intervention. It is important to support children with a developmental delay or disability as early as possible.

Working Together With Your Family

Our ECA practitioners are trained professionals in early childhood development and will tailor a support pathway based on your child's individual needs.

They will work closely with you to:

- Understand the needs of your child and family.
- Assess your child's needs including what is going well and where your child may need further help.
- Support you to set goals with you and your child.
- Provide helpful information, connect you and your child with the most appropriate community and mainstream supports in your area.
- Provide short term Early Supports if eligible
- Facilitate access to the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) if eligible.
- Support you to implement your child's approved NDIS plan as your NDIS Contact.
