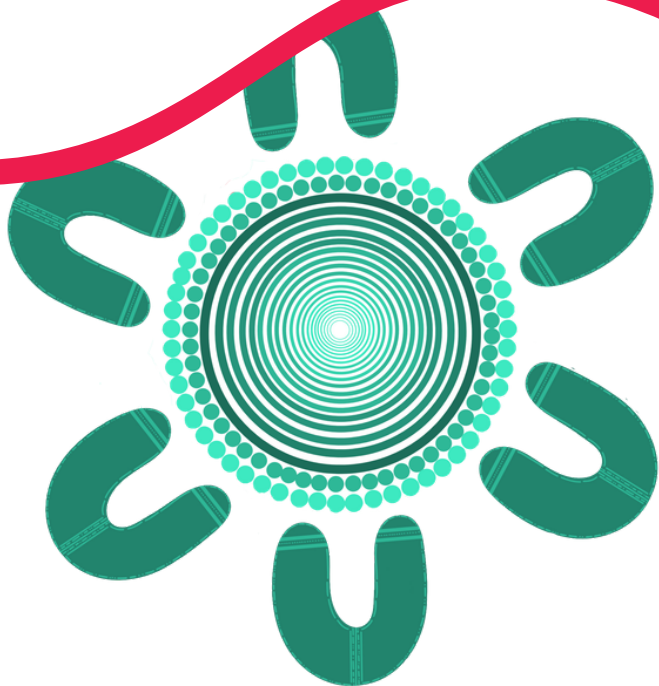


Uplyft acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we live, work, and operate and all Aboriginal peoples across Australia.
