### Swing Space Transportation

Our Brent Bus Depot at Providence Park (X-Park) supports:

- Early Care and Regular Morning Buses
- Flexible Afternoons: ride home after school or join Brent's wide range of enrichment programs—soccer, musical theatre, clubs, and more
- Customizable Dismissal Plans: families can choose a different bus or pick-up plan for each day of the week
- Real-Time GPS Bus Tracker: families can follow bus locations and timing for added safety and peace of mind
