A Message from Our Chair

From above the forest canopy, a Great Blue Heron descends gracefully upon the Alplaus Kill to pluck a meal from beneath the rippling surface. The moment captures nature's resilience and beauty, offering just one glimpse into the treasures we strive to protect. I invite you to read the Annual Report for the Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy. The report highlights our successes in 2025, as we work to build our conservation portfolio and welcome more visitors to our trails throughout this beautiful region.

More than 160 acres were protected in 2025, bringing our total conserved land to nearly 16,000 acres. This report features the Alplaus Kill Preserve in Glenville, our first preserve in Schenectady County, as well as the Worlds End Farm conservation easement in Charleston, Montgomery County, located between the Catskills and the Adirondacks. MHLC was also fortunate to expand its staff, welcoming Megan Stevenson as Land Protection Manager and Todd Gardner as Project Manager for Bender Melon Farm.

We believe it is important not only to protect land but also to make it accessible, engaging, and inspiring. In partnership with Schenectady County, MHLC installed three interpretive panels along the Wolf Hollow Road nature trail. Participation in our expanded Summer Hike-a-thon Scavenger Hunt reached a new high, and in August, Trail Tunes brought music and music lovers to the Bender Melon Farm Preserve trails. We look forward to hosting this event again in 2026. You can read about these events and other meaningful opportunities we've provided to connect people with nature on the following pages.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I thank Executive Director Mark King and the MHLC staff for their dedication. We are grateful to our volunteers for their time and energy, and to our supporters and sponsors for their generosity in 2025. We also thank outgoing board members Allie Middleton and Alyson Brody for their commitment and lasting contributions.

Conservation Success

Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy added 160 acres to our conservation portfolio in 2025. Included in this acreage was the new Alplaus Kill Preserve, our first preserve in Schenectady County.

Alplaus Kill Preserve | 54 acres in Alplaus, NY

In April, MHLC announced the acquisition of a 54-acre property in the hamlet of Alplaus in Glenville. This property, generously donated by Gray and Vicki Watkins, marks MHLC's 23rd preserve and our first in Schenectady County. In preparation for the July opening, our stewardship team and volunteers developed a trail system showcasing the property's unique features, including over a half mile of frontage along the Alplaus Kill, a tributary that flows southward to the Mohawk River. This feature, along with the property's open fields, woods, and creek, highlights its ecological value and scenic beauty.

Worlds End Farm | 105 acres in Charleston, NY

In December, MHLC completed a conservation easement protecting the 105-acre Worlds End Farm in the Town of Charleston. The Montgomery County property has about 80% forest cover, with the remaining open space dedicated to wetland protection, sheep grazing, and food production. The forest contains a wide variety of species, including red pine, mature Eastern hemlock, birch, aspen, and healthy beech trees. The land offers breeding habitat for several birds listed as species of greatest conservation need. Worlds End Farm is located within the Catskills to Adirondack Corridor, a critically important wildlife linkage recognized by the Staying Connected Initiative. Property owner Sarah Ryhanen hopes her move to protect the farm will influence other landowners in this significant corridor to do the same.

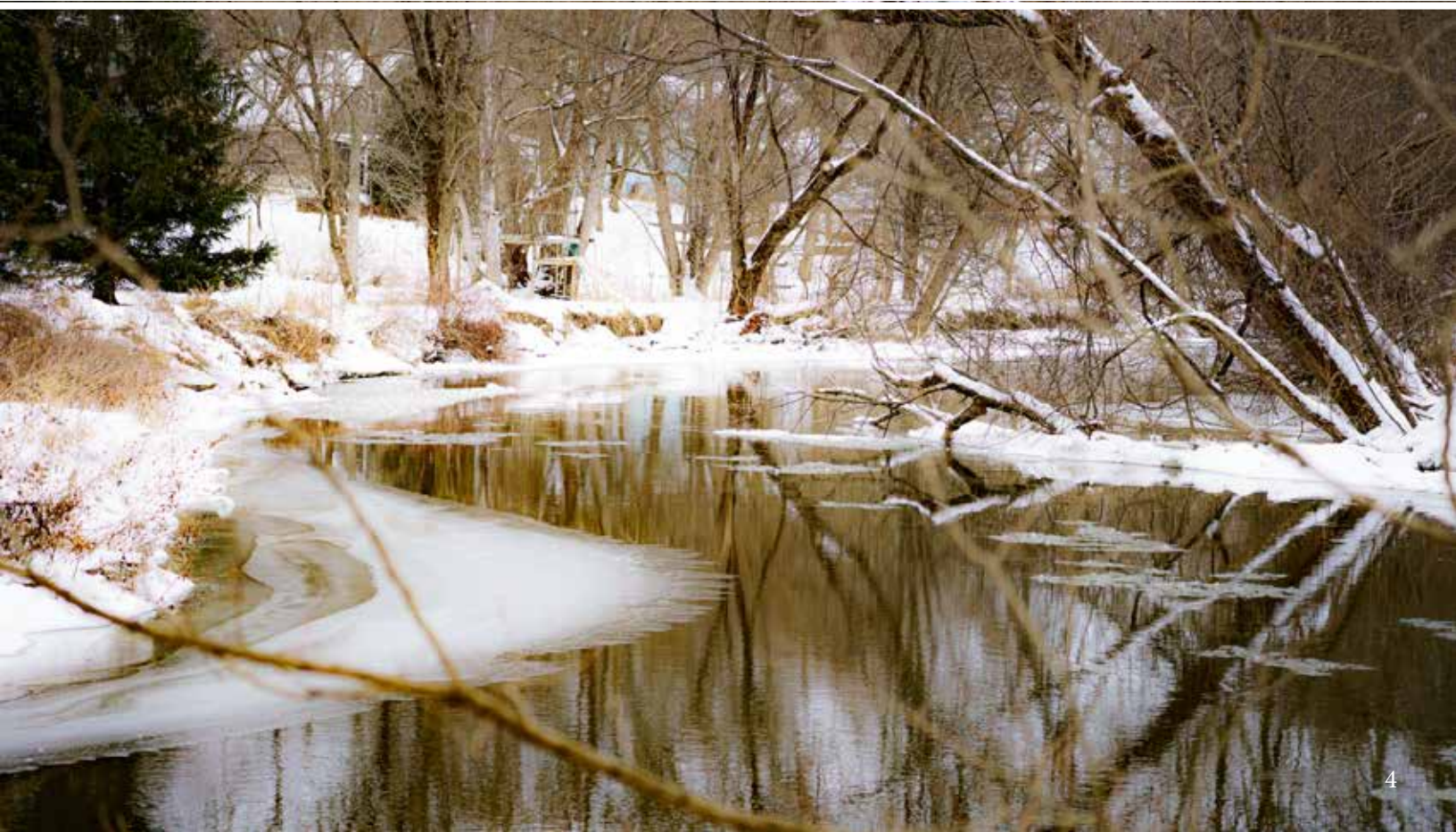
Ryhanen's passion for living off the land inspired the farm's unique use as an immersive retreat and sustainable living learning venue. In 2023, Ryhanen formalized the farm's use as a learning venue, establishing the Worlds End School of Thought Agriculture and Craft as a 501 (c)3. The school offers a variety of classes, self-guided residencies, and an "incubator" program to foster other small, land-based business.

The Worlds End Farm conservation easement was supported with funding from the New York State Forest Conservation Easements for Land Trusts Program (FCELT) and New York's Environmental Protection Fund. FCELT is administered by the Land Trust Alliance, in coordination with the state Department of Environmental Conservation. Funding was also provided by The Nature Conservancy's Climate Resilience Program to support Mohawk Hudson Land Conservancy's acquisition costs and long-term stewardship of the Worlds End Farm conservation easement.

Fox Preserve | 2-acre addition in Colonie, NY

In December, a donation of approximately 2 acres of land adjacent to Fox Preserve was finalized. The parcel was donated by Dr. Patricia Fox, whose 70-acre donation in 2015 established the preserve. Fox Preserve is currently 74 acres. The parcel is located along River Road and would have been highly vulnerable to residential development. Securing this open space behind Fox Preserve's parking lot is critical to MHLC's ability to manage the preserve for the public enjoyment.

Connecting People to Nature

MHLC strives to create meaningful connections between the lands we protect and the community members living in our service area of Albany, Schenectady, and Montgomery Counties.

Events

In 2025, MHLC hosted 20 events engaging nearly 800 people. The events included wildlife tracking, forest bathing, bird watching, plant identification, a native garden tour, and more. New this year was a hike led by Wild Hudson Valley exploring Hollyhock Hollow Sanctuary through the lens of Northeastern Native languages, history, and folklore.

On July 15, we hosted an opening day celebration at the Alplaus Kill Preserve. Among the 45 attendees were Senator Patricia Fahy, representatives from Schenectady County, and preserve donors Vicki and Gray Watkins. The event included a trail walk to enjoy the summer views of the fields, forest, and creek. Attendees received a surprise gift in honor of the day, a limited edition preserve t-shirt provided by Vicki and Gray.

The whimsical MHLC gnomes were back for the annual Summer Hike-a-thon Scavenger Hunt, which continues to draw hundreds of visitors to the preserves. This year, three challenges were added to the event as an incentive to visit more locations. In August, MHLC hosted our first-ever Trail Tunes event featuring live music at four different stations along the trails at Bender Melon Farm. The event was a huge triumph, drawing well over 200 people to the preserve and introducing MHLC to a whole new audience.

Fall Fundraiser

The 2025 annual fall fundraiser, *An Evening on the Mohawk River*, was held in September at River Stone Manor in Schenectady. The festive evening celebrating MHLC's conservation work in the Capital Region was enjoyed by more than 200 supporters. Thanks to the generous support of our guests, honorary committee members, sponsors, and auction donors, the event was an incredible success, raising over \$84,000.

During the event, we celebrated three individuals who have significantly contributed to local conservation. The event honoree was Tom Bessette, whose photographs capture the beautiful landscapes and fascinating wildlife of the Capital Region. Gray and Vicki Watkins received the Saving Special Places Award in recognition of their generous land donation that established the Alplaus Kill Preserve. Matt Sinnenberg received the Dan Driscoll Volunteer Leadership Award in recognition of his outstanding efforts in stewarding our preserves.

Stewards Circle

MHLC's annual Stewards Circle event was held at Strawberry Fields Nature Preserve, where landowner Jeff Leon and his wife Judy, welcomed 60 MHLC supporters to their residence adjacent to the preserve. The event featured dinner on the lawn with expansive views of the fields and surrounding forest, a tour of the private trails surrounding the house, and a tour of Lovin' Mama Farm, an organic, no till farm run by Jeff's son, Matthew, and his wife, Corinne. The annual event also gives donors an opportunity to learn more about new conservation projects.

Connecting People to Nature, continued...

Nature Bus

In partnership with CDTA, MHLC worked to coordinate another 20-week season of Albany Nature Bus. The service ran from May 24 to October 4, connecting community members to Thacher Park, Tivoli Lake Preserve and Farm, Six Mile Waterworks, the Albany County Helderberg-Hudson Rail Trail, DEC's Five Rivers, and the Fisher Trail (MHLC in partnership with Five Rivers). We continue to hear positive feedback, with partner locations reporting bus riders participating in the free programs and events offered throughout the season and many repeat users.

The Albany Nature Bus was made possible thanks to funding from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's (DEC) Division of Communication, Education and Engagement, Saratoga Capital District Regional State Parks Commission – The Centennial Access for All Campaign, and the Albany Pine Bush Preserve Commission.

Interpretive Signage at Wolf Hollow Road

Over the years, MHLC helped conserve nearly 400 acres of land surrounding Wolf Hollow Road in Glenville. This year, in partnership with Schenectady County, MHLC installed three interpretive signage panels along the nature trail at Wolf Hollow Road. The signs enhance the visitor's experience, offering a closer look at the history, geology, and botany that make this area a unique destination.

MHLC expresses heartfelt gratitude to the local academic and historical advisors who helped create a narrative for the interpretive signs: Don Rodbell, Union College Jane and John Wold Professor of Geosciences; Bill Buell, Schenectady County Historian and semi-retired *Daily Gazette* reporter; and Steve Young, former chief botanist for the New York Natural Heritage Program.

Art on the Rail Trail

MHLC's volunteer committee, Art on the Rail Trail (ART), was awarded a \$15,000 grant from Albany County to complete a master plan. The committee engaged local art expert Judie Gilmore to develop a comprehensive Master Plan for Public Art along the Albany County Helderberg-Hudson Rail Trail. The plan, which will be complete in 2026, will guide the committee in its efforts to engage the surrounding communities and bring new artworks to the Rail Trail.

In 2025, the miniMoCA 518 gallery featured installations from artists Betsy Brandt and Charles Steckler. ART also connected creative community members with the opportunity to construct gnome or fairy-themed sculptures for the annual scavenger hunt event. Sculptures from 19 local artists were hung from trees alongside the Rail Trail.

Volunteers

The 2025 stewardship season was another success due to the 120+ volunteers who assisted our stewardship crew at 16 workdays. Over the course of the year, they contributed nearly 500 hours of volunteer time. In addition to ongoing preserve maintenance, our team dedicated much effort to the new Alplaus Kill Preserve. A community workday was also arranged, giving neighbors the opportunity to collaborate with MHLC staff on the project. This year we also hosted four corporate workdays and several additional workdays for local church and school groups

Our largest workday was the Earth Day Workday at Bender Melon Farm. In addition to trail maintenance and roadside clean up, volunteers also helped to install six picnic tables and spread mulch next to the Ryan C. Long Bridge.

In addition to workdays for MHLC volunteers, our stewardship staff also hosted four corporate workdays. The workday events are designed to give participants a meaningful experience that has a lasting impact on conservation and outdoor recreation opportunities in the community.

MHLC event and office volunteers continue to play an essential role in helping MHLC connect people to nature, serving as ambassadors for our organization. They participated as hike sweeps in 20 events, staffed the MHLC table at eleven community outreach events, and provided valuable assistance at our office with mailings and other administrative tasks. Larger events like the Trail Tunes and Scavenger Hunt would not be possible without the help from our volunteer team.

Staff

MHLC welcomed Eleanor McAden (UMass Amherst) and Nuala Breen (UAlbany) as Summer Land Stewards to assist at the preserves over the busiest season. Eleanor and Nuala played a critical role in managing MHLC's 23 preserves.

In April, Megan Stevenson joined our staff as Land Protection Manager. Megan is working with private landowners, government agencies, and other not-for-profit partners to find creative ways to achieve shared conservation goals. Megan played a key role in completing the conservation easement at Worlds End Farm this year.

In December, Todd Gardner joined our staff as Project Manager. Todd is currently managing several projects at the Bender Melon Farm Preserve and Hollyhock Hollow Sanctuary. These include re-use of the barn at Bender Melon, the removal of a residential structure at Hollyhock, and a project to remove invasive species at Hollyhock.

Highlights from the Field

In addition to routine preserve maintenance, MHLC completed multiple projects to provide better access to the preserves and restore the natural landscapes.

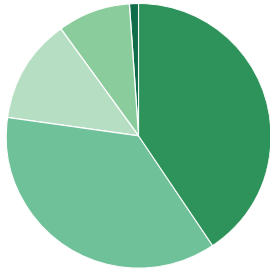
Improving Public Access

In 2025, a new parking lot was installed at Bender Melon Farm. The parking area is located off 85A, near the site of the old farmstead. To mark this as the official entrance to the preserve, a new kiosk and signage were installed at the site. A parking area was also installed at the new Alplaus Kill Preserve by Schenectady County Public Works. MHLC staff and volunteers installed a permanent kiosk near the parking area, replacing the temporary kiosk used for the opening celebration. After significant damage from flooding, the Town of Guilderland restored the entrance and parking area at Lower Bozen Kill Preserve. At Van Dyke Preserve, staff and faculty from Bethlehem Central School District volunteered to resurface the gravel parking area.

Landscape Restoration

Improving the natural landscapes at Bender Melon Farm Preserve continues to be a priority for our team. Projects in 2025 included work done under an NRCS EQIP (Natural Resource Conservation Service -Environmental Quality Incentives Program) contract. EQIP supported the intensive restoration of an 11-acre field along Rt. 85A, converting the depleted agricultural space into grassland and pollinator habitat. The EQIP contract also helped fund invasive species removal efforts throughout the hedgerows and early successional thickets crisscrossing the preserve. Volunteers from a local church coalition, Earth Care, dedicated their time and considerable person-power to removing hundreds of Tree of Heaven stems, a prolific invasive at the preserve.

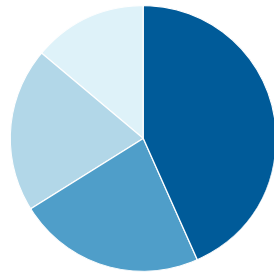

OPERATING REVENUE

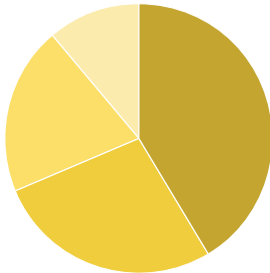

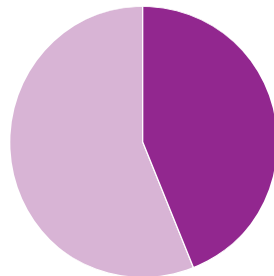

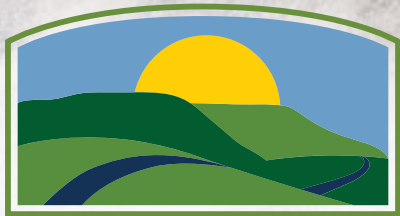
