

Visa

It is the sole responsibility of the delegate to determine whether they need a visa and applying for their own visa. Non-US citizens who require a visa to enter the US should start the visa application process early to allow sufficient time for the visa application process. The visa processing time has increased post Covid-19.

If you are residing in Africa or Asia and need a visa to enter the US, we recommend starting the visa application process 5-6 months prior to the event date.

Invitation letter

Insurance


The DHIS2 Symposium registration fee does not include or cover insurance.

Weather

The month of February in the Washington, D.C., area tends to be cold, however, it is usually warmer towards the end of the month. Overnight low temperatures are likely to be around mid-30s F (\pm 2C) towards the end of the month. Afternoon high temperatures tend to be in the lower 50s F (\pm 10-11C) later in the month. Check the weather forecast before traveling and pack accordingly.
