Are You a Follower or a Fan of Jesus? Matthew 4:12-25

The First Followers:

Many followed Jesus, but not all were fully <u>devoted</u> followers, some were just <u>seekers</u>.

The First Message:

Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at **hand**.

Six times in the Book of Acts, early Christians were called "people of the <u>way</u>."

Bringing others to Jesus was one of the fruits of new **followers** (believers).

Andrew brought **Simon**, Philip brought **Nathanael**.

Together they influenced <u>James</u> and <u>John</u>.

Jesus was looking for <u>seekers</u>. He told "wanna-be" followers to <u>seek</u> first the kingdom of God.

Examples of 3 "wanna-be" followers:

Follow Me and <u>continue</u> to follow Me for the rest of your life.

Following Jesus means going where He **goes**, doing what He **does**, and **proclaiming** what He proclaimed.

Following Christ is not about convenience, it is about **commitment**.
