- The Public Policy Committee has a goal of finalizing the **legislative agenda** earlier this year. This will help us make a bigger impact during legislative session in 2026. Please take this survey to tell the Committee what you believe the Council's legislative priorities should be for the 2026 session: <u>WA DD Council Priority Areas for 2026</u>. The survey will close in one week, on 6/13/25.
- Our 5 Year State Plan Survey is open for one more month. We have close to 1,000 responses, however the group of respondents is not very diverse. Please consider sending our survey to people in your networks who can help us get more diverse responses. We are especially looking for the following populations' perspectives: people with disabilities who are between the ages of 14 and 40, people of color, people living in rural communities and the LGBTQ+ community.
