

No Paid Services Program Update - Senate Bill 5394

Substitute Senate Bill 5394 directs the Developmental Disabilities Community Services Division to discontinue case management outreach to people not receiving a service from DDCS and continue to respond to requests for services and resources, effective July 2025.

To meet this directive, DDCS no longer assigns a designated case resource manager to individuals who are not currently receiving a DDCS service.

A person on the No-Paid Services caseload now contacts DDCS if they have questions about accessing services or need support.
