Your Card can be used in everyday or emergency situations.
This includes:

- shops, cafes, banks and government departments
- with family, friends and work colleagues
- airports, buses, trains, trams, taxis and Ubers
- with first responders, such as police, ambulance, fire.

People can read your Card and scan your QR code to learn more about how they can assist you.
