All strings may be purchased directly from Dusty Strings or from some Dusty Strings harp dealers. In addition, the nylon monofilament strings are standard diameters that may be found at a number of other suppliers. The gut strings may also be purchased from other suppliers, and as it is very important to use equivalent diameters, we have provided information above about acceptable gut string substitutes. The wound strings are specific to Dusty Strings harps, and it is unlikely that you will find substitutes that will work, unless you order them custom-made.

Important: Use of strings other than the diameters and materials specified here will invalidate your warranty; the total amount of string tension has been carefully calculated and exceeding this amount may put your harp at risk.
