That focus transformed into 22 BAPTISMS of kids and adults, including my oldest daughter, and made for an unforgettable year. That mentality flowed out of the building as we **served our city** through **28 different events** with **Frankfort Forward**. From school clothing drives and holiday meals, to partnering on Kentucky State's campus, to serving kids impacted by incarceration, again and again God got the glory.

Multiply showing up for our city during the **flooding** that rocked our community was a witness of love and faith in Jesus. Our display of the gospel was not just in word, but also in deed. None of this happens without the powerful team God has assembled, with our **SMALL GROUPS DOUBLING** this past year and our volunteer teams adding many more team members and **two new teams**.

We also transformed our building, outside and inside. Our first impression is a tangible representation of what we are believing God for in the future, with **murals and stations** dedicated to building the kingdom. An improved volunteer headquarters and new chairs for the worship center have made for a better Sunday experience. I will never forget the week of the flood, praying over those seats and seeing **401 people, our highest attendance ever**, worship as we celebrated Easter Sunday.

This 2025 Annual Report is a moment to look back and reflect on all God did this last year. I hope you will take a moment to praise the Lord and **CELEBRATE** what He has done through the willingness of a bunch of people with **crazy faith in year three** of planting Multiply.




