# Sign Up Process

Residents can sign up for Alert Iowa online through an online portal. Go to the **Polk County EMA webpage**, or to **Smart911.com** to sign up.


Once you are at the sign up page you will be asked to create an account.

#### You must provide:

- Your name
- Phone Number
- And create a username and password


Your e-mail address is optional.

The system also allows you to designate someone who will provide assistance in setting you up and managing your account. If you choose this option the person assisting will get reminders to update your information on an annual basis.

# **Adding an Email**

Once you create your account the next few pages will review your personal information.


If you choose to not include an email you will be asked to verify. If you entered in a mobile number, you will be asked to verify the carrier by a call.

## **Adding an Address**

You will then be asked to enter an address. This is needed to confirm which alerts you will be offered.

Note: You can add multiple address in different counties in your profile in a later step.





#### **Alerts**

Once you verify your address, the next screen will display the alerts available in your county.


Note: The system automatically subscribes you to all alerts. To opt out, you can click on the blue check box next to the alert you do not want.

## **Selecting Your Language**

You can also choose the language of your choice for alerts. If your county translates their messages to that language, you will receive it in your preferred language. If they do not, the message will still be delivered in English

# **Refining Your Alerts**

You can also uncheck the box next to the first alert category to deselect all at once. You can then select the individual alerts and modes you prefer.



## **People & Medical Information**

You can add multiple people under one account, making this a great way to sign up a whole household. If you optin to provide your personal information, such as personal medical, access, and functional needs information. Polk County can use this information to send preemptive messaging to groups who may need extra time to evacuate, or rely on generators.

### **Account Settings**

You can update your password, profile update reminders, and account assistant information in the Account Settings tab.

### **Addresses**


The system allows for multiple addresses across counties. The addresses provided will activate which alerts you have the ability to opt into.

#### **Alerts**

Your main page tells you which alerts you are subscribed to and which alerts you are eligible to add. You can update your preferences any time through the Alerts Tab in the toolbar located at the top of the page. You can also provide personal information to assist first responders under preferences.

#### **Other Account Information**

You can populate information about emergency contacts, preferred providers, vehicles and animals in your household. Polk County can use this for response and recovery efforts and in their 911 emergency communications centers when you place a call.



#### **Preferences**

You can manage the option to provide personal information to assist in response, evacuation, and recovery efforts under "Preferences".





#### **Additional Information**

You can add additional addresses and phone numbers to your profile.
