

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ELKHART, IOWA,
BY AMENDING PROVISIONS IN CHAPTER 107

COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

BE IT ENACTEED, by the City Council of the City of Elkhart, Iowa;

SECTION 4. SECTION MODIFIED. Chapter 107 – COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS, Section 107.04 COLLECTION OF FEES, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

“107.04 COLLECTION OF FEES.

*The fee for the collection of recyclable materials from each eligible residence is **\$4.78** per month, effective on the bill dated July 1, 2026. Such charges shall be due and payable under the same terms and conditions provided for payment of a combined service account as contained in Section 92.04 of this Code of Ordinances. Service may be discontinued in accordance with the provisions contained in Section 92.05 if the combined service account becomes delinquent, and the provisions contained in Section 92.08 relating to lien notices shall also apply in the event of a delinquent account.”*

REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage and approval as provided by law.
