Help & Guidance

At Dormer Cottage Funeral Home in Tamworth, we understand how overwhelming it can feel when someone close to you passes away. That's why we've created a simple, helpful guide to support you through the practical steps that follow a bereavement.

The guide covers what to do immediately after someone dies, involvement of the Coroner, how to register a death, arranging a funeral, and costs.

What to do immediately after a death has occurred

We are on-hand 24 Hours a Day to help you following the loss of a loved one. You can call us anytime on 01827 234 001 for our immediate assistance and professional advice.

Death in Hospital

If your loved one has passed away in Hospital, someone capable such as a Nurse or Doctor will confirm that death has occurred. Your loved one will then be transferred to the on-site mortuary. We can collect your loved one from the Hospital Mortuary as soon as you've registered the death.

It is the responsibility of the Doctor who last treated your loved one to issue a 'Medical Certificate of Cause of Death' to confirm the cause of the death which is then presented to the Medical Examiner who will review the notes and if happy with the cause of death will approve the certificate and forward to the local register office.

Once the Register Office has received the approval from the Medical Examiner you can proceed to register the death. If the Doctor cannot confirm a cause of death, they will refer the death to the Coroner for further investigation.

Funeral Guidance

Death at Home

If your loved one has passed away at Home, someone capable such as a Nurse, Paramedic or Doctor will need to attend to confirm that death has occurred. Once the death has been confirmed we can attend the home address immediately to convey your loved one into the care of our funeral home.

It is the responsibility of the Doctor who last treated your loved one to issue a 'Medical Certificate of Cause of Death' to confirm the cause of the death which is then presented to the Medical Examiner who will review the notes and if happy with the cause of death will approve the certificate and forward to the local register office.

Once the Register Office has received the approval from the Medical Examiner you can proceed to register the death. If the Doctor cannot confirm a cause of death, they will refer the death to the Coroner for further investigation.

Death in a Care / Nursing Home

If your loved one has passed away in a Care / Nursing Home, someone capable such as a Nurse, Paramedic or Doctor will need to attend to confirm that death has occurred. Once the death has been confirmed we can attend the home to convey your loved one into the care of our funeral home.

It is the responsibility of the Doctor who last treated your loved one to issue a 'Medical Certificate of Cause of Death' to confirm the cause of the death which is then presented to the Medical Examiner who will review the notes and if happy with the cause of death will approve the certificate and forward to the local register office.

Once the Register Office has received the approval from the Medical Examiner you can proceed to register the death. If the Doctor cannot confirm a cause of death, they will refer the death to the Coroner for further investigation.

Funeral Guidance

Death in a Hospice

If your loved one has passed away in a Hospice, someone capable such as a Nurse or Doctor will need to confirm that death has occurred. Some hospices have an on-site mortuary and if so, your loved one will temporarily rest there, however if the hospice does not have an on-site mortuary, we will attend immediately to convey your loved one into the care of our funeral home.

It is the responsibility of the Doctor who last treated your loved one to issue a 'Medical Certificate of Cause of Death' to confirm the cause of the death which is then presented to the Medical Examiner who will review the notes and if happy with the cause of death will approve the certificate and forward to the local register office.

Once the Register Office has received the approval from the Medical Examiner you can proceed to register the death. If the Doctor cannot confirm a cause of death, they will refer the death to the Coroner for further investigation.

Following a Sudden Death

If your loved one has passed away suddenly and unexpectedly, you must call 999 and report to the police. The Police will then arrange for a paramedic to confirm death. Once death is confirmed, a report will be sent to the GP of the deceased. In most circumstances the Coroner will transfer the deceased to the Coroners Mortuary pending investigation into the cause of death.

If the GP is able to confirm a cause of death, then issue a 'Medical Certificate of Cause of Death' to confirm the cause of the death which is then presented to the Medical Examiner who will review the notes and if happy with the cause of death will approve the certificate and forward to the local register office.

In circumstances where the GP is unable to confirm a cause of death, or if the death occurred in suspicious circumstances, accidental or potential suicide, the Coroner will then investigate to find the cause.

Funeral Guidance

Involvement of H. M. Coroner

The job of the Coroner is to investigate the circumstances surrounding a death to find the exact cause. To do this they often carry out an examination of the body as well as taking samples of blood and tissue to help pinpoint the exact cause of death. Once they have completed any physical investigations they will release the body for Cremation or Burial.

Should the Coroner not find a Cause of Death immediately they will issue an Interim Death Certificate so you can proceed with Funeral Arrangements. Once a Cause of Death is found, you will be required to register the death at the Register Office.

Registering a Death

To register a death you must visit the Register Office in the district where the death occurred. Most register offices operate on an appointment only basis. You can only attend once the Medical Certificate of Cause of Death has been approved by the Medical Examiner, or the Coroner has instructed you to do so.

At the Register Office you will be issued with a 'Copy of Entry to Death Register' also known as a Death Certificate. We recommend obtaining 3-5 copies of this, as you may need official copies for Banks, Insurances etc. You will also be issued with the 'Green Form' which you need to hand to your Funeral Director. This certificate enables the burial or cremation to take place.

If you don't live close to the Register Office in the district where the death occurred, you can register the death at your local Register Office by declaration. You will then receive the Death Certificate & Green Form in the post.

Arranging a Funeral

When you feel ready to begin making the arrangements for your loved ones Funeral, contact us anytime on 01827 234 001 to arrange an appointment to visit Dormer Cottage Funeral Home, or alternatively for one of our team to visit you in the comfort of your own home to begin planning.



Burial or Cremation

Choosing a final resting place for your loved one is one of the first decisions you'll need to make. When opting for a Burial you will have a permanent place to visit and pay respects to your loved one. When opting for a Cremation you can choose to keep your loved ones ashes at home, or alternatively bury / scatter them somewhere meaningful.



Choosing a Venue

If you are holding a Funeral Ceremony for your loved one, you will need to choose an appropriate venue. If your loved one is to be cremated you can hold the ceremony at the Crematorium Chapel. Similarly for burial, cemeteries often have an on-site cemetery chapel. Alternative venues include churches, village halls, community centres, or even in the comfort of your own home.

Choosing a Coffin or Casket

From the most simple cardboard Coffin, to veneered and solid wood Coffins, to steel and bronze caskets, choosing a suitable final vessel for your loved one to rest in is an important decision to make. When opting for Cremation most families opt for a Veneered Wood Coffin whereas with a Burial, many opt for Solid Wood or something more eco-friendly such as a Willow Coffin.



Visiting your loved one

If you decide you'd like to spend time with your loved one prior to their Funeral, you are welcomed to our Funeral Home where your loved one will be laid out in our beautiful Chapel of Rest. Our Chapel of Rest overlooks our country courtyard garden featuring some beautiful wildlife and water features. In the summer the patio doors open and families can sit outside to gather their thoughts.



Ceremonial Vehicles

We provide a Chauffeur Driven Hearse to convey your loved one and any floral tributes to the Crematorium or Cemetery. We also provide Chauffeur Driven Limousines to convey mourners to and from the Funeral Ceremony. We offer both Mercedes and Bentley fleets to suit.

Burial or Scattering of ashes

Following a Cremation you have the choice of what to do with your loved ones ashes. Some families keep their loved ones ashes at Home whilst others arrange to lay them to rest by burial or scattering. Whilst permission is required before scattering, there are many beautiful places that ashes can be laid. to rest, for example at sea.



Headstones & Memorials

We work with an Independent Monumental Masons to offer a range of Headstones and Memorials. Following a Burial we can help you to choose an appropriate memorial for your loved one. Should you already have a memorial in place, we can arrange for it to be removed and stored safely prior to burial, then re-fixed with a new inscription afterwards.

This Coffin has been designed as an affordable yet quality Coffin specifically for non-attended Cremations. When opting for this package, it is not possible to upgrade / choose a different Coffin.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Where will my loved one be kept?**
We will collect your loved one and take care of them at our Funeral Home, Dormer Cottage until the day of their cremation.
- **Can I visit my loved one in the Chapel of Rest?**
Yes of course. Your loved one will receive the same care and preparation they would if you were arranging a traditional funeral.
- **Can I provide clothes for my loved one to be dressed in?**
Yes of course. Alternatively we can provide a simple white shroud.
- **Will I know when the Cremation is taking place?**
Of course. We will inform you once the date / time of the Cremation has been secured with the Crematorium.

Direct Cremation Package

- **Can I attend the Crematorium for my loved ones Funeral?**

With a non-attended Cremation, it is not possible for anyone to attend the Crematorium. The Coffin is conveyed to the Crematorium early morning.

- **Is there any ceremony held?**

With a Non-Attended Cremation there is no ceremony held connected to the cremation itself, however many families choose to hold a ceremony separate from the funeral / cremation at a date, time and venue of their choosing.

- **Which Crematorium will the Cremation take place at?**

Your loved ones Cremation will take place at the beautiful Hammerwich Crematorium in Burntwood, Staffordshire.

- **Can I have my loved ones ashes back?**

Of course. We will collect your loved ones ashes from the Crematorium and take care of them at our Funeral Home until you're ready to collect them, or to arrange for them to be laid to rest.
